SolCon Capital focuses on innovative tech investments for long-term growth and industry transformation.

Andile played a crucial role in developing the New Dawn Satellite Company and Seacom, enhancing Africa's connectivity. He also serves on boards of firms like inq., Comsol, and C-Squared, contributing to public policy through the ITU, ICANN, and the African Union.
